THE FESTIVAL

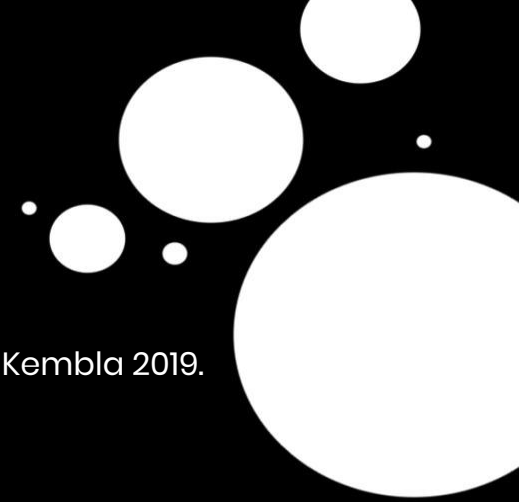
Wonderwalls Port Kembla 2019 (WW PK19), will be held February 15th – 17th, 2019.

LOCATIONS

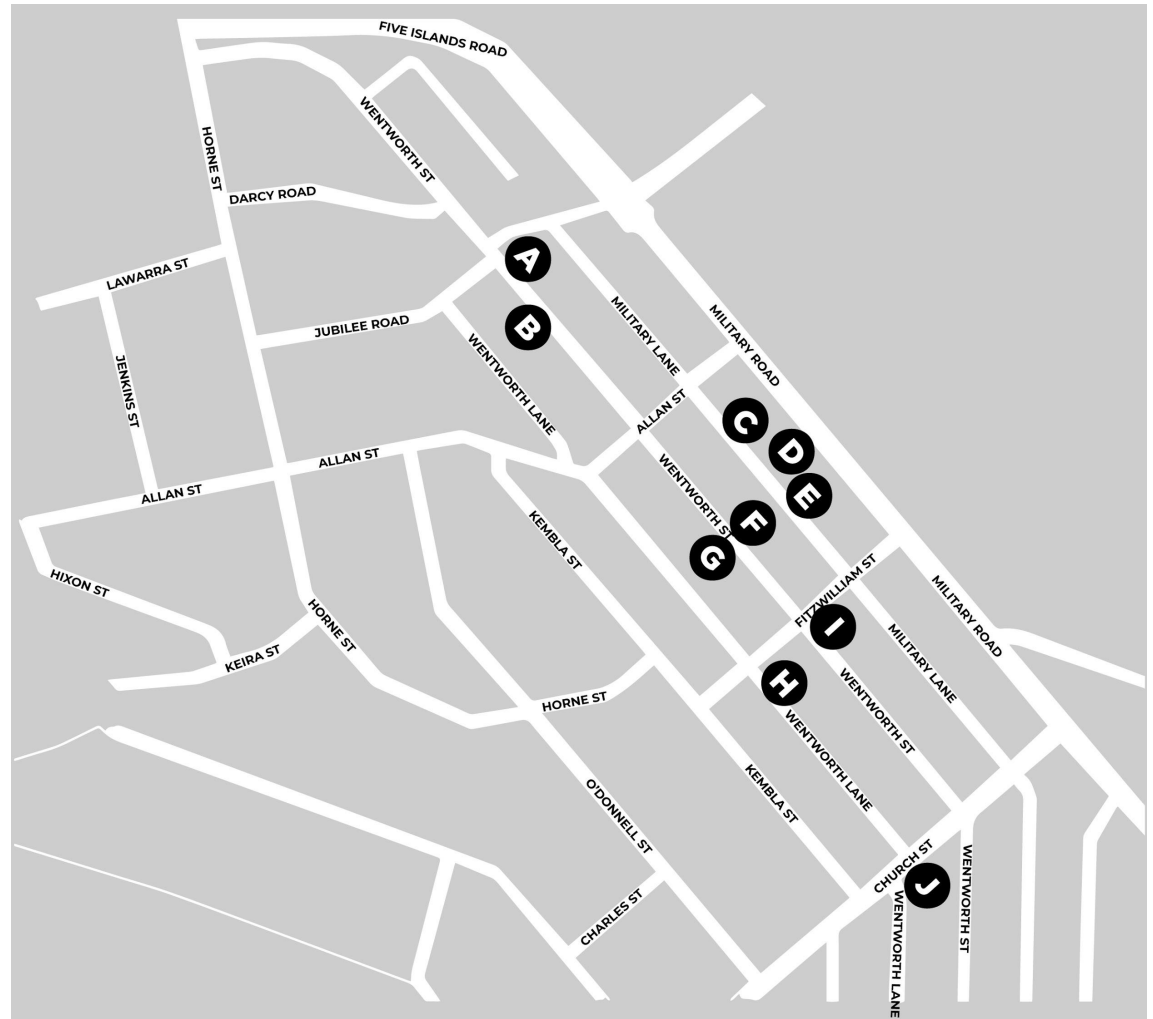
WW PK19 will be located in the centre of Port Kembla.
